Beyond Borders, Between Hearts

At the age of 14, Vanessa Jerome left her deeply dysfunctional home in Australia and by 19, she had made her way to New York City with just a few hundred dollars in her pocket. Years of struggle followed until she found faith at Brooklyn Tabernacle at 30 and her life was transformed through a series of remarkable events.

Today, she serves as President and CEO of The Harold C. Smith Foundation where she pioneered a powerful new collaboration of 11 foundations who support the Middle East, North Africa (MENA) region of the world.

The effort began when Vanessa felt a strong calling to bring the foundations within her sphere of influence together to see how they could make a greater impact. Despite her initial trepidation, she reached out to other foundation leaders, and they responded with great enthusiasm.

As they worked through their collective goals and objectives, Vanessa was astonished to see a spirit of unity among the group that was nothing short of a miracle. They unanimously agreed to focus their granting efforts on a multi-year initiative to support refugee women in Lebanon. And soon they had identified the Lebanese charities that they wanted to support.

After sailing along smoothly through these decisions, the collective was finally ready to give. But for the first time, they realized what a daunting challenge that would be. The logistics of handling annual contributions from so many different foundations – along with the legal, tax, and governmental hurdles of cross-border grants to five different Lebanese charities – seemed like an impossible task.

That's when TrustBridge Global stepped in with a solution that felt like answered prayer. They set up a donor-advised fund for the group especially designed to make global giving easy. The foundations made contributions to the fund and TrustBridge Global handled all the complicated tracking, reporting, and international granting. "TrustBridge truly provided unwavering support at every step," Vanessa says. "And I honestly don't think the collective giving would have worked without their help."

The group of foundations, which has become known as the MENA Collaborative, is currently in the midst of a new endeavor to collectively support the Sudanese refugee crisis in Egypt with a projected budget of \$3 million. TrustBridge Global will once again be there to help. "There's nothing like having an international granting partner who shares your heart for changing lives, and the expertise to make it happen," Vanessa says.

Heroes of Hope

When Fiona Smith's three-year-old son, Sullivan, faced the challenges of a rare muscle condition that severely impacted his breathing and mobility, she and her husband embarked on making their home more accessible. Tragically, Sullivan passed away just as the adaptations were completed.



Through their grief, they founded Sullivan's Heroes, an NGO in the UK, with the mission to help other families facing similar challenges. "Until you've been through that process, you don't realize the expense and extensive requirements of adapting your home," Fiona says. Launched in 2016, Sullivan's Heroes has supported 184 families in adapting their homes for their children's special needs.

One of these families is Aurora's. Born with Pitt-Hopkins Syndrome, five-year-old Aurora needed significant home modifications. International donors used TrustBridge Global to quickly and easily contribute a significant gift to Aurora's Big Build.

So far, the project has raised 67% of its goal, enabling construction of a downstairs bedroom, wet room, accessible porch, and modified garden. "Once complete, the project will change our everyday lives," Aurora's parents say. "Aurora will be safely cared for around the house, and that will have a huge impact on our whole family."

Fiona says working with TrustBridge Global has been instrumental. "It's a good facilitator for giving larger amounts of money internationally," Fiona says. "And TrustBridge provides visibility for Sullivan's Heroes to a greater audience of international donors."

With building costs rising yearly, Sullivan's Heroes hopes to continue their mission of ensuring every child has a safe, accessible home.
